His most important exhibitions have been the "Chorus" installation for the Rockefeller Center, New York; the Paik Hae Young Gallery, Seoul-Korea; the Columbia Museum of Art, Columbia Amalia Lacroze Fortabat museum, to name a few.

Gabriel's interest in the visual arts led him to an early encounter with contemporary arts, which influenced his study and unique creative process. He works across various disciplines, including industrial design, in which he works a wide range of disciplines, creating everything from furniture and household objects to commercial to privets projects.

In 2014, he moved his studies and workshop to Japan, where he exhibited the "Scholar, for the City of Fujisawa Art Space, Japan. He also received an Honorable mention from the Amalia Lacroze Fortabat museum in Buenos Aires, Argentina.
